IA Recommendation Highlights

Below is a summary of the major changes we recommend to the current website architecture, presented previously in our Findings and Recommendations. The navigation and wireframes that follow this section are fully aligned with the changes proposed, showing how they can be applied.

One Library, Three Locations

- A new approach to the website architecture should be explored, placing all centralized content under a single umbrella (the Library system as a whole), while breaking location-specific content into separate spaces (Valley, Cascades, and Guin).

- Consistent naming conventions for the library system as a whole and the three library locations should be introduced, clarifying how these categories relate to one another.
- The navigation system should clearly identify which library location the user is visiting and how this content differs from the centralized resources of the library system as a whole.

Navigation & Wayfinding

- Reader-friendly navigation labels should be applied, using no specialized, insider terms.
- Wayfinding elements including intuitive menus, breadcrumbs, and highlighted navigation labels should indicate where a user is and how to navigate elsewhere as desired.

Consolidating Content

- A reasonable reduction of interlinking and duplicate content should be achieved.
- Any LibGuide content that does not fit the definition of a research guide should be integrated into a page within the new website system (or removed if no longer relevant).

Supporting New Users

- A concise, broad-brush overview of all that OSU Libraries offer should be made available.
- Content and architecture should be strategized to serve the needs of advanced users (to quickly perform common functions) as well as new users (providing in-context guidance).
- The principal research tools of the site (1Search, Databases, Archives, etc) should be grouped and contextualized so that first-time users can understand them in context.
